
Hungarian higher education


- 21 State Universities

- 2 Non-state Universities of applied sciences
- 3 State Colleges
- ▶ 28 Non-state Colleges



- Three cycle "Bologna" degree structure (Bachelor, Master, Doctoral)
- Some undivided programmes: medicine, law, agriculture

Motivation for internationalization

- Cultural diversity in Higher Education is a core value
- ► Combat challenges in HE: demography, finance, globalization
- Resource for development (incoming, outgoing direction)
- Internationally in focus (EU, World, state)
 - Legal framework for mobility
 - Financial support
 - ► Comparable, transferable standardized learning outcomes



Internationalization in action – the Hungarian case

- European mobility schemes
 Erasmus+: large component dedicated to mobility (Erasmus mobility 4k+)
 - ▶ Intensive marketing, Campus Mundi
 - ▶ Increasing international students' number in HU to 40 000 by 2020
 - ▶ Participation on HE fairs, conferences
 - ▶ Alumni of international students
 - Scholarships for Hungarian students (20 % to be abroad at least one semester by 2023)
 - ▶ Internationalization audit: quality in provision HE services 10 Universities
- Part of the Hungarian strategy for Higher Education
 - Stipendium Hungaricum Scholarship (2016/17: 3000 students to HU, 50 countries)
 - Bilateral State Scholarships
 - ▶ HRC activities: Science Without Borders, coordination of international projects

Cooperation at University level

Wide variety of institutions and programs Part in many institutional development plans Openness to cooperate – mutual benefits Practice in establishing links, MOUs, legal details Exchange of students, staff, joint research Good reputation of Chinese students Focus areas: engineering, sciences, art (music), medicine ...there are great possibilities outside Budapest.

Universities in Hungary

- High standards in education
 - Accreditation: Hungarian, international (ENQA)
 - ► English as a language of instruction generally introduced
 - ► Historically good in sciences, engineering, IT, medicine
 - Market driven education (cooperation with companies, employers' org.)
- For Universities: international partnership is important
- Multicultural environment
- Living standards high, good value for money from students perspective
- Excellent research Universities: not just education, not just BSc/MSc
- Good entry point: MRK/HRC (coordination, information)
