





What does international credit mobility mean?

- Erasmus programme opens towards 3rd countries (from 2014: "partner countries")
- Short-term mobility for students & staff
 - Short cycle, BA, MA and PhD students (with certain regulations)
 - Outgoing from and <u>incoming to programme countries</u>
 - Traineeship not supported yet (provisioned for 2018)





Who can participate?

Programme countries/THEY APPLY WITH PARTNER COUNTRIES

- 28 EU Member States
- 5 additional countries: Iceland, Liechtenstein, FYROM, Norway, Turkey

 All other countries except: Switzerland, Gulf Coopeartion countries

Types of mobility

- students, academics, non-academic staff
- no quota for target groups
 - e.g. 100% student or 100% academics are both accaptable
- all academic levels
- in any academic area
- student mobility: 3-12 months / academic cycle
- academics and staff: min. 5 day to 60 days (plus travel)
 - min. 8 hours teaching / week



Grant support for individuals

- •750 euro/month for incoming **students to** Hungary
- •650 euro/month for outgoing **students from** Hungary
- •140 euro/day for incoming **staff to** Hungary (if <14 days)
- •160 euro/day for outgoing **staff from** Hungary

Top-up travel cost for everyone

100 and 499 KM: 180 EUR/person 500 and 1999 KM: 275 EUR/person

2000 and 2999 KM: 360 EUR/person

3000 and 3999 KM: 530 EUR/person

4000 and 7999 KM: 820 EUR/person

8000 KM and above: 1100 EUR/ person





Erasmus quality framework

- Erasmus Charter for Higher Education for Partner countries, the principles of the Charter are embedded in the inter-institutional agreements
- Inter-institutional agreements to set mobility flows & preconditions- signed before mobilities start
- Learning Agreement for students
- Mobility Agreement for staff
